Rachit Shetty, 17 years, joined in August 2016.

Parents: Mrs. Savitha & Mr. Raghunath Shetty. Mother is a home maker and Father works in a hotel.

Siblings: Rakshat,23 yrs, Graduate. Rajat,22 yrs, works in a call centre.

Parent Speak: After joining the centre, Rachit is able to follow basic instructions at home. He has learnt to do job work in vocational training, string beads, shell peas and corn. He attends to his personal hygiene independently. He is able to serve himself and eat, dress independently.

Together Speak: Rachit has started relating to people apart from his parents and his tolerance for engaging with people has improved a lot. Rachit shows a lot of interest in

paper plate manufacturing and our sheltered employment initiative include plans for Rachit in this area.

Mother is a homemaker and Father works in Pfizer Ltd. **Parent Speak**: Our biggest concern for Arnav was that he should do constructive work and complete a task on his own. Today he can do job work, paper plate making, block printing and few bakery tasks on his own. That's a big achievement. He is also taking part in group exercises which earlier he resisted.

Together Speak: Arnav joined Together when the centre opened and is touchingly possessive about his work space. Arnav, like his peers, earns a stipend for the work he does at Together. We are trying to introduce work that can be done in assembly line for youngsters like Arnav.





Alby Chiramel, 22 years, joined in October 2017.

Parents: Mrs.Daisy Chiramel & Mr.Jose Chiramel. Mother is working in accounts & administrative function and Father is at home due to heart ailment.

Siblings: Noel Jose Chiramel, working with Disney cruise line in Florida.

Parent Speak: Alby has learned quite a few skills like –primary and secondary packaging in the bakery, paper plate making, participating in sales and exhibitions and interacting with customers. He has recently been introduced to manufacturing in the bakery. He has learnt to communicate in a better way with his friends, teachers & others.

Together Speak: Alby loves to work in our shop and shows his understanding that Together is his workplace and he has an important role to play here.

Mouzam Siddique, 20 years, joined in October 2018.

Bakery

Students learn to manufacture and pack a dazzling range of products.

The bakery is FSSAI certified and run with professional inputs and supervision.

Paper plates

Students are taught how to clean raw material, prepare batches for manufacture and stock the paper plates, ready to be dispatched to the vendor.



Job work

Students learn to assemble labels and thread them together for our corporate clients. Approximately 6,000 labels a month are assembled.

Paper bag printing

Students learn block printing and prepare bulk quantities of recycled paper bags and jute bags.



Shop management

Students are trained to take care of different jobs in the shop – interacting with customers, organising products in the shop, sales and

exhibitions, keeping a record of stocks and data entry of shop records.
